Today we celebrate the ordination and installation of our newly elected elders and deacons, we praise God for His faithfulness in providing leaders to His church.

In the morning, we are called together in worship. This Sunday we conclude our morning sermon series that has taken us through the book of Micah entitled "Hope Beyond the Shadows". This series looks at the prophetic message of honest judgement and incredible hope that is found in the promised Messiah. This week we will look at Micah 7:14-20, where Micah declares that God's forgiveness, a display of His covenant love, transforms and encourages us.
