# **Introduction**

Brothers and sisters in Christ, the sacrament of baptism reminds and assures us that we share in the death and resurrection of Christ, and are incorporated into Christ's holy church. Baptism proclaims the faith of the church. The water of baptism is a sign and seal of God's promise to cleanse us from sin, renew us, and reconcile us to Himself in Christ.

Baptism is the sign and seal of God's promises to His covenant people. In baptism, God promises by grace alone to forgive our sins, to adopt us into the body of Christ, the church, to send the Holy Spirit daily to renew and cleanse us, and to resurrect us to eternal life. This promise is made visible in the water of baptism. Water cleanses, purifies, refreshes, sustains; Jesus Christ is The Living Water.

#### Vows

Ryan and Kelli, since you have presented Ava Rae for baptism,

we ask you the following questions before God and his people.

Do you promise:

to instruct Ava Rae in the truth of God's Word,

to direct her in the way of salvation through Jesus Christ,

to pray for her,

to train her in Christ's way by your example, through worship, and in the nurture of the church?
