WORSHIP NOTES

We welcome you to worship this week. We are glad you are worshipping with us. Today we celebrate Palm Sunday, remembering Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

In the morning we continue our series "Humiliation to Glorification" drawing us to the celebration of Easter, we continue with the humility of Christ in experiencing rejection by His own people, opening God's Word to Mark 15:1-15. In this journey we continue to examine the different ways that Jesus displayed His humility. We are encouraged to face rejection in the confidence of God's love for us and sovereignty in all things. We have the privilege of preparing ourselves for the celebration of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday during our morning service.

In the evening we invite you to join us as we continue our evening series, looking together at the Sermon on the Mount, the teaching of Jesus that is recorded for us in Mathew, opening God's Word to Matthew 6:1-4. As we continue to examine the Sermon on the Mount, we are reminded that we are called to give, but our giving is not for our glorification but for God's.

We praise God that He has called us to worship Him in joy and in fellowship!

*Please note that the cross will be having 3 different colors draped on it the next couple weeks until Easter. Here are the meanings behind each color:

The Purple Cloth Drape that you see today is the symbolic color of royalty and is placed on the cross for Palm Sunday, the day Jesus Christ entered Jerusalem as a King riding a donkey. The purple cloth represents Christ as King, reminding us that Christ is our Savior and King, and we are mere mortals saved only by His grace and mercy.

The Black Cloth Drape that you see for Maundy Thursday and Good Friday represents the death of Christ on the cross for our sins. The black cloth also represents the mockery, suffering, and crucifixion that Christ endured for our sake.

The White Cloth Drape that you see on Easter Sunday represents the resurrection of Christ and that He was raised again for our justification! The White Cloth represents joy, light, innocence, purity, triumph, glory, and victory over sin and death!
