## CELEBRATION OF HOLY COMMUNION

### God's Invitation and Promises

This is the joyful feast for the people of God! People will come from east and west, from north and south and sit at the table in the Kingdom of God. When our risen Lord was at the table with his disciples, he took the bread, blessed and broke it, and then gave it to them. This is the Lord's Table. Our Savior invites those who trust him to share the feast that He has prepared.

### Thanksgiving for the work of Christ

Minister: Thanks be to God; Christ makes us one. The peace of Christ be with you.

**People: And also with you.**

Minister: Lift up your hearts

**People: We lift them up to the Lord.**

Minister: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God

**People: It is right for us to give thanks and praise.**

### The Sacrament

Lord, our God, send your Holy Spirit so that this bread and cup may be for us a reminder of the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. May we be united with Christ and remain faithful in hope and love. Gather your whole church, O Lord, into the glory of your kingdom.

Minister: The bread that we break is a sharing in the body of Christ.

*(Pass the elements)*

Minister: Before we partake of the bread, let us say together;

**People: We who are many are one body for we all share the same loaf.**

Minister: The body of Christ was broken for you. Take, eat, remember and believe.

Minister: The Cup for which we give thanks is the sharing in the death of Christ.

*(Pass the elements)*

Minister: Before we partake of the cup, let us say together;

**People: The cup that we drink is our participation in the death of Christ.**

Minister: The blood of Christ was shed for you. Take, drink, remember and believe.

### Response of Praise

Minister: Praise the Lord, O my soul;

**People: All my inmost being, praise his holy name.**

Minister: Praise the Lord, O my soul,

**People: And forget not all his benefits-**

Minister: Who forgives all your sins

**People: And heals all your diseases,**

Minister: Who redeems your life from the pit

**People: And crowns you with love and compassion**

Minister: Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain,

**People: To receive power and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!**

### Prayer

Minister: Let us, with one voice, respond together with a prayer of gratitude and praise.

**People: Loving God, thank you for feeding us at Your Table and for uniting us as Your Body. You have given us a share in the ONE bread and the ONE cup and made us ONE in Christ. Help us to bring the joy of this feast with us wherever we go.**

**We pray through Christ Jesus, our Lord and Savior. AMEN.**
